The **Faculty Library** is conveniently located on the campus.

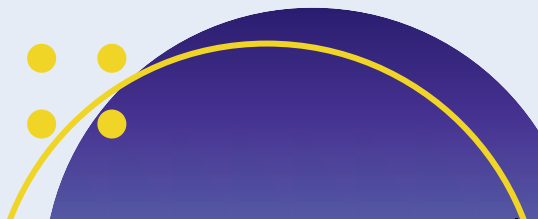
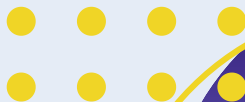



Students at the Faculty can pursue Bachelor's, Master's and Doctoral degrees in both Polish and English, with both full-time and part-time study options.

The Faculty is a **community of scientists conducting research projects across various disciplines**, including philosophy, political science and administration, sociology, security sciences, and international relations.





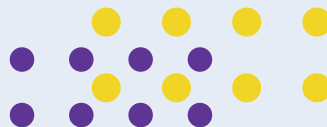

International cooperation


The Faculty of Social Sciences is one of the most internationalised units at the University of Wrocław, with numerous international agreements and enhanced global collaboration.



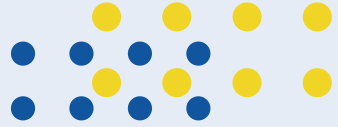
We implement such programmes as Erasmus Mundus: “Global Studies”, “MITRA” and others.



We also offer the Double Degree programme: its completion in International Relations guarantees the **acquisition of diplomas awarded jointly by the University of Wrocław and the University of Padua or Ruhr University Bochum.** For Political Science students, a joint degree is available with the **Georgian Institute of Public Affairs in Tbilisi.**



Studying in English involves multiple options of participating in international exchange programmes, including Erasmus+, CEEEPUS, or ISEP, as well as international student conferences and summer schools.

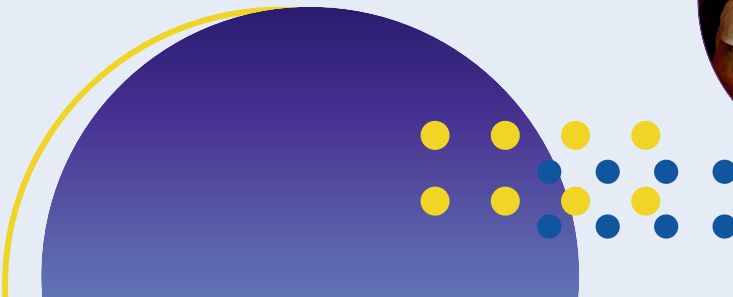
